


Weddings & Celebrations





Welcome to Cheval The Edinburgh Grand. We are delighted you are considering holding your event with us. Over the years we have been privileged to host a large number of ceremonies and celebrations in this historic building. Quite frankly it is one of the best parts of the job!









Setting the Scene

Formerly the headquarters of The Royal Bank of Scotland until its refurbishment in 2018, Cheval The Edinburgh Grand includes fifty luxuriously appointed apartments, a reception room on the fourth floor we call the Games Room, and an accompanying cocktail lounge and restaurant, The Register Club, also located on the fourth level.

The nature of the individual, quirky spaces at Cheval The Edinburgh Grand makes them ideal for intimate weddings and celebrations, and we can be flexible depending on your wishes and the number of guests.

You could host a private dinner in the Directors' Suite, or a drinks reception in the three-bedroom penthouse with its panoramic city views.

It's important to note that we are not a dedicated wedding venue with a pre-ordained bronze, silver and gold set of packages. This is by choice, and because we want to work with our guests to ensure that every event is unique and reflects their personality as well as our own.



Accommodation

When it comes to staying overnight, we can accommodate individuals, couples and families in our selection of studio, one-, two- and three-bedroom apartments. The extra space available in our apartments and fully equipped kitchens make both short and longer stays simple to arrange, and there is plenty of room for getting ready on the big day.





The Games Room

Located on the fourth floor, the Games Room is our dedicated events space.

This room can be tailored for a wedding ceremony, sit down meal or standing reception. The number of people that can comfortably be accommodated is indicated below.

Private dining (round tables): 50
Private dining (one large table): 25

The Games Room






The Penthouse

Boasting unrivalled views of the city, this three-bedroom apartment has a private terrace that can accommodate up to 60 for a standing reception. This is an ideal spot for hosting post-ceremony drinks and photos before returning to the Games Room for a sit-down meal.

The penthouse features a contemporary open plan kitchen/diner with comfortable seating set against an immense glass backdrop and giant wrap-around outdoor terrace.

Standing reception: 60











The Directors' Suite

As befits a space that was once the luncheon room for the bank's Directors, this one-bedroom suite has a grand table in the middle of the suite seating up to 12. Also located on the same level as the Games Room, this apartment bursts with period features; original fireplaces and accent wood panelling add to the gentrified and romantic atmosphere. The cleverly designed room can be tailored either for a sit-down meal or a standing reception.

Configuration Maximum capacity

Private dining: 12
Standing reception: 30











The Register Club

In a previous existence this space was the Royal Bank of Scotland's Committee Room, now transformed into a cosy and welcoming bar and lounge space. The Register Club is open to both residents and guests, and offers champagne, cocktails, a selection of lighter dishes and afternoon tea, seven days a week.

With its double heighted ceiling and elegant wood panelling, it's not hard to imagine yourself getting comfortable in one of the many booths that line the walls and planning that special occasion or event with friends and family. It is also possible to book areas of The Register Club for smaller gatherings.













Pricing

Every event held at Cheval The Edinburgh Grand is different, and as such we do not have set packages. Although your event can be as small as you like, prices start from £55 per person for a sit-down threecourse meal, and for a minimum group size of 10.

If your booking includes accommodation, we can offer advantageous rates for the wedding party bookable using a specific code on our website.






Hawksmoor








Honeymoon






Honeymoon

Frequently Asked Questions

How many people can attend an event?

Cheval The Edinburgh Grand caters for smaller, intimate celebrations and weddings, and as such we welcome up to 50 guests.

Can I provisionally hold space?

Absolutely. We are happy to hold a date for up to seven days, after which we will contact you to either release or confirm your booking with a deposit.

Do I need to put down a deposit to secure my booking?

Once you've found a date that suits you and have decided to go ahead, we ask for a 20% deposit of the agreed fee.

What types of ceremonies are possible?

Whether it is secular or religious, your ceremony can be conducted according to your wishes. Depending on the size of the ceremony and the number of guests, this can be conducted in the Games Room, the Directors' Suite or in the Penthouse.

Who will be my point of contact?

We have an events coordinator who will be your primary point of contact when planning your event. They will be responsible for booking the space, organising any associated accommodation in the building and advising on what we as a venue can arrange.

Do you have a list of recommended suppliers such as caterers, florists, hairstylist and bakeries?

We do indeed and will be happy to give you some recommendations.

Do you accept outsider caterers?

The team at The Register Club has years of experience catering for groups both small and large. They can prepare everything from a traditional wedding breakfast meal to themed feasts for all types of occasions.
